OPENING

A silent Hail Mary is said.

V. Lord, open my lips.

R. And my mouth will proclaim your praise.

V. O God, come to my assistance.

R. O Lord, make haste to help me.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. Praise to you, Lord, King of eternal glory.

Psalm 95 *Come, Let Us Sing to the Lord*

Come, let us rejoice in the Lord; let us shout with joy to God our Savior.

Let us come before his face with thanksgiving; let us shout with joy to him with psalms.

For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods.

For the Lord will not reject his people; for in his hand are all the ends of the earth, and the heights of the mountains are his.

For the sea is his, and he made it; and his hands formed the dry land.

Come, let us adore and fall down before him; let us weep before the Lord who made us.

For he is the Lord our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

LESSON 1

LESSON 2

SIRACH 24:15-16

And so I was established in Zion, and in the holy city likewise I rested, and my power was in Jerusalem. And I took root in an honored people, in the portion of my God, his inheritance: and my dwelling is in the full assembly of the saints.

Blessing: Through the Virgin Mother, may the Lord grant us salvation and peace. Amen.

R. Blessed are you, O Virgin Mary, who carried the Lord, the Creator of the world: you gave birth to him who made you, and you remain a virgin forever.

V. Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you.

R. You gave birth to him who made you, and you remain a virgin forever.

LESSON 3

SIRACH 24:17-20

I was exalted like a cedar in Lebanon, and like a cypress on Mount Zion; I was exalted like a palm tree in Cades, and like a rose-bush in Jericho; like a fair olive-tree in the plains, and like a plane-tree beside the water in the streets. Like cinnamon and fragrant balm I yielded a sweet fragrance; like choice myrrh I gave a sweet smell.

But you, O Lord, have mercy on us.

Blessing: May the Virgin Mother obtain for us salvation and peace. Amen.

R. Happy indeed are you, O holy Virgin Mary, and most worthy of all praise: for from you arose the Sun of justice, Christ our God.

V. Pray for the people, plead for the clergy, intercede for all the devoted: let all who keep your holy commemoration feel your help.

R. For from you arose the Sun of justice, Christ our God.

V. Glory to the Father...

R. Christ our God.

TE DEUM

Said from Christmas until Septuagesima, and from Easter until Advent. On other days, omit the Te Deum and say the third Responsory instead.

We praise you, O God; we acknowledge you to be the Lord.

All the earth worships you, the Father everlasting.

To you all the angels cry aloud, the heavens and all the powers therein.

To you the cherubim and seraphim continually cry:

Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of hosts; heaven and earth are full of the majesty of your glory.

The glorious company of the apostles praises you.

The admirable fellowship of the prophets praises you.

The white-robed army of martyrs praises you.

The holy Church throughout all the world acknowledges you:

the Father of infinite majesty; your adorable, true, and only Son; also the Holy Spirit the Comforter.

You are the King of glory, O Christ.

You are the everlasting Son of the Father.

When you took upon yourself to deliver man, you did not disdain the Virgin's womb.

When you had overcome the sharpness of death, you opened the kingdom of heaven to all believers.

You sit at the right hand of God in the glory of the Father.

We believe that you will come to be our Judge.

We therefore ask you to come to the aid of your servants, whom you have redeemed with your precious blood.

Make them to be numbered with your saints in glory everlasting.

Save your people, O Lord, and bless your inheritance.

Govern them and lift them up forever.

Day by day we bless you.

And we praise your name forever and ever.

Vouchsafe, O Lord, this day to keep us without sin.

Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy on us.

Let your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, as we have hoped in you.

In you, O Lord, have I hoped; let me never be confounded.

VERSICLE

V. Grace is poured upon your lips.

R. Therefore God has blessed you forever.

LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

COLLECT

O God, who willed that your Word should take flesh in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary at the announcement of the angel: grant to those who ask you that we who believe her to be truly the Mother of God may be helped by her intercession with you. Through the same Lord Jesus Christ your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, world without end. Amen.
